#### INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Anchor BCI Global Technology Fund aims to maximise the long-term return for the investors by way of a global equity portfolio actively investing in companies that create and benefit from advances in technology. The portfolio is suitable for investors with an aggressive risk profile.

#### INVESTMENT PHILOSOPHY

The portfolio may invest in global and local equity securities, property shares, property related securities listed on exchanges and assets in liquid form, preference shares, debentures, debenture bonds, money market instruments and assets in liquid form. The manager may include the following unlisted financial instruments: forward currency, interest rate and exchange rate swap transactions for efficient portfolio management purposes. The portfolio's equity exposure will always exceed 80% of the portfolio's net asset value, and at least 80% of net asset value will be invested outside of South Africa, with no more than 80% exposure to assets of a specific geographical region.



# RISK PROFILE: HIGH


- This portfolio has a higher exposure to equities than any other risk profiled portfolio and therefore tends to carry higher volatility due to higher exposure to equity market

#### FUND MANAGER COMMENTARY AT 31 MAR 2023

The Anchor BCI Global Technology Fund returned 17.3% in 1Q23 and an annualised return of 6.9%% since its inception on 6 June 2019. This compares with the benchmark return for 1Q22 of 25.6% and an annualised 23.7% since inception. The fund's 1Q23 performance can also be compared against the FTSE All World Index, which rose performance can also be compared against the FTSE All World Index, which rose 11.7% in rand terms. The first quarter of 2023 saw a broad rally in technology (tech) shares. One contributing factor is the large decline in valuations seen in 2022. The January effect arguably was a contributor. Additionally, the possibility of US inflation being close to its peak led to yields declining to end the quarter below where they started in 2023 and below their recent highs of the past twelve months. Large-cap tech generally had a very strong 1Q23. Although earnings growth is expected to be relatively muted in 2023 for these companies, their earnings may be viewed as more defensive than earlier-stage companies as we enter a widely anticipated recession. There has been huge excitement over artificial intelligence (Al) spurred by OpenAl's ChatGPT. Key industry participants have termed the product Al's "iPhone moment". Potential ramifications of this fed through into valuations for key semiconductor companies, which were strong performers over the quarter. No outright purchases or sales were made during the quarter under review. The fund's equity content ended the quarter at 94.5%, up from 93.7% at the end of December 2022. The balance of 6.3% was mainly
